Footnotes

TORAZO tracked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn, drove past the leader in the stretch and cleared the field in the final stages. PROVEN WARRIOR set the pace early, angled off the rail in the turn then faltered late in the stretch and held place in the final stages. IMPASSABLE CANYON chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but missed place in the final stages. SHARM was unhurried early, shifted into the three path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. COPPERPLATE chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn while making a bid but weakened late in the stretch drive. TWINSANITY was bumped at the start, fanned into the seven path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. CEEJAY'S MISTER was bumped at the start, had brief speed then folded up. SARATOGA SYNDICATE was bumped at the start and through after a half.
