Footnotes

SISTER KAN stalked the pace, raced in the three path on the turn, was asked in the four path into the stretch, made an outside bid at the three-sixteenths, dueled with the runner-up into the final sixteenth and proved best under strong urging. JENDA'S AGENDA showed good speed, set the pace under some pressure, vied in the two path on the turn, was asked in the three path into the stretch, dueled with the winner into the final sixteenth then was outfinished while clear for the place. NINETEENTH STREET was well placed just off the pace, raced just behind the leader while along the rail on the turn, passed the five-sixteenths under urging, was asked for more outside the quarter-pole, lost touch with the top two under a drive in upper stretch, moved out at the furlong marker and weakened but clearly held the show. QUICK RELEASE raced just off the pace, went around the turn in the two path, was roused near the five-sixteenths and came up empty. DURANGO tracked the pace, dropped back while three then two wide on the turn, moved out under a drive in upper stretch and failed to respond. AIKEN TO BE was rated on the outside, came under urging in the four path on the turn and faltered. HEAD-ON REPLAY WAS NOT PROVIDED FOR THIS RACE
