TRIPLE CHELSEA was rated just off the pace, stalked the leader in the two path on the turn, was asked at the three-sixteenths, took over before the furlong marker and edged clear under strong urging. THERE'SYOURTROUBLE showed good speed, set the pace, raced inside on the turn, was set down in upper stretch, lost the lead before the furlong marker and was outfinished while able to get the place. MISS GOSSIP (IRE) settled on the outside, advanced five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and finished willingly to just get the show. STALLION HEIRESS was asked from the gate then rated just off the heels of the leader, drafted inside on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and was out-kicked. HOTSHOT ANNA was rated just off the pace on the inside, jostled with OURS TO RUN then checked at the five-sixteenths, moved out in upper stretch and improved position. BURMA ROAD settled at the rear of the field, went four then five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. NINETEENTH STREET bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, raced between horses in the two path on the turn, jostled with HOTSHOT ANNA at the five-sixteenths and lacked the needed response. JUSTA LADY was rated under a strong hold, went three wide while between horses on the turn, was asked for her best in upper stretch and came up empty. WEALTHY SHIPMAN settled towards the rear, went two then three wide on the turn and was no factor. PLEASANT TALES broke out at the start, settled on the outside, went four wide on the turn, spun five wide into the stretch and faltered. (Rail at 15 Feet)
