MISS KENTUCKY tracked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn, took over and inched clear down the lane, but was under a long drive late then dug in and gamely held in the final stages. TREBLE chased the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn, made a bid three wide down the lane but was bumped and bothered under the long drive and missed in the final stages. ASTROLLINTHEPARK stalked the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn, made a bid down the lane from between horses, came out a bit and bumped foe then missed in the final stages. BARBARY HALL swung into the six path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. NINETEENTH STREET fanned into the five path in the turn and faded late in the stretch drive. WHEATFIELD was never involved. DEFY set a fast pace, shifted into the three path in the turn and caved down the lane.
