MISS CAPPY brushed the gate then was bumped and squeezed back at the start, rallied six wide around the turn and finished well. ROCKZILLA flashed early speed, steadily faded. ADELAIDES PROSPECT failed to menace on the rail. JOVIAL JOYCE was used up after a half along the inside. VICTORY MORNING had little left after a half on the rail. SNEAKY LOVE prompted the issue three wide, tired. LADY MODOC off a step slow then in tight start, trailed three wide.
