PATRIOTS RULE was settled last from well out of striking distance for the opening five furlongs, gathered momentum nearing upper stretch, split rivals just off the inside leaving midstretch to challenge for command between the leaders and kicked clear late under firm left handed pressure. MALIBU PRO was rated just out of striking distance tracking the pacesetter between foes into the backstretch, made steady progress to challenge the leader nearing upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner's bid but edged a rival for the place honors. AIRLITE, urged to the lead from the outset while angling to the inside, dictated the pace on a clear margin to upper stretch, resisted a rival's challenge past the furlong marker but yielded to the top pair late. ACES HIGH broke awkwardly, recovered quickly to track the pacesetter outside foes in second flight, was bumped leaving the half mile marker, then exchanged some contact with HIGHT SECURITY racing four deep into the far turn, continued in that path into upper stretch but had no final kick. HIGH SECURITY was rated just off the second flight between foes in early stages, was urged between foes bumping ACES HIGH then continued to exchange light contact with that foe racing three deep between foes into the far turn making brief progress, but flattened out racing into upper stretch. SMOOTH STROKE tracked the pacesetter as part of the second flight along the inside but retreated after a half.
