Footnotes

MOON LAUNCH set the clear pace on the inside, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the lead in upper stretch, brushed with ROCK ON KITTEN near the eighth-pole, dueled gamely with that foe in the final furlong and prevailed under strong urging. ROCK ON KITTEN went around the first turn in the two path, tracked the pace down the backstretch, chased in the two path on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, took a narrow lead at the three-sixteenths, brushed with MOON LAUNCH near the eighth-pole, dueled with that foe in the final furlong and missed while just able to get the place. WHATA PERFECT

DAY settled on the inside was roused on the far turn, gained into the final furlong, moved out late and finished fast to just miss the place while well clear for the show. PLEASE SIT DOWN moved in early, settled on the inside while well back, was urged along on the far turn, shifted three wide near the five-sixteenths, swung eight wide into the stretch and improved position. MR. MIKE moved in early, was well placed on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, was put to the whip outside the quarter-pole and tired. TWELFTH LABOUR went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was asked while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SLIPPY went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the front on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, spun four wide into the stretch and came up empty. DYNAMIC FORCE went around the first turn in the two path, settled in the front half of the field, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and also failed to rally. BIG BEAUTIFUL WALL was taken in hand near the wire for the first time, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled towards the rear, raced inside to the two path on the far turn and was no factor. GENTLE WARRIOR was hustled from the start, settled in the two path, was roused while four wide into the stretch and failed to respond. ANOTHER MYSTERY went three wide on the turns, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor. NAPOLEON'S EMPIRE went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was hard ridden midway down the backstretch, raced three wide on the far turn and never reached contention. FEVER TEMPLE went three to four wide on the turns, came six wide into the stretch and also failed to respond. WHO'S YOUR FAVORITE went three wide on the first turn, lingered near the back of the field, raced inside to the two path on the far turn and showed little.
