WAR FILM stumbled awkwardly at the start, raced inside on the first turn, settled at the rear, started the far turn in the two path, shifted four wide at the five-sixteenths, was roused while six wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up late. WAR TREATY went three wide on the first turn, followed the solo leader from second, advanced in the two path on the far turn, took the lead outside the quarter-pole, lost the lead in upper stretch, fought back into the final furlong, regained the lead at the sixteenth-pole but was denied while able to get the place. HANDSOME HONEY went around the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, moved closer while shifting from the two path to the four path on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and finished with good courage to just get the show. LIMNERY went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced closer while three to four wide on the far turn, took the lead in upper stretch, swapped back to his inside lead at the furlong marker, lost the advantage around the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished then just lost the show. IAN GLASS went four then three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, moved closer while two to three wide on the far turn, was roused at the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. TOM MANAGEMENT broke a step slow, went three wide on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, was urged along while moving from three to five wide on the far turn and failed to rally. TOM'S LAST GENERAL settled on the inside, moved closer on the far turn, shifted three wide into the stretch and came up empty. MOON LAUNCH quickly sprinted clear, raced in the two path on the first turn, drew off on the backstretch under some urging, shortened stride significantly while inside on the far turn, was collared inside the five-sixteenths and stopped.
