LAND BATTLE bobbled at the start, chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn, rallied down the lane and was gaining in the late stages. KATE'S GOLDEN DUDE stalked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. HARMAC fanned into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. TIA FLOR was never a threat. FINNEGAN (IRE) steadied at the start and was no factor. CUTLER was through after a half.
