Footnotes

DANCE PROUDLY vied for the lead along the inside, settled back to press the leader through the turn while near the inside, bid into the lane, repelled challenger when straightening then drew clear and was kept to the task to the wire. BRO was in the two or three path through the turn when last, angled into the six path for the drive and rallied through mid-track. TOMMYTOM chased the dueling leaders through the turn while in the three path, bid through the final eighth and was outfinished for the place spot. TOUGH STUFF was in the three path through the turn, came into the lane from the four path then shifted from the four to the seven path late while gaining energy. KATE'S GOLDEN DUDE was near the rail into the lane then lacked a closing bid. SATURDAY TRYST vied for the lead two wide into the lane then faltered once straightened for the drive.
