### Footnotes

GETTIN EVEN chased the pace from the four path through the turn, bid into the lane from the four path, inched up to a short lead with a furlong to go then edged clear between calls and was all out late to last. CHARGE CARD was unhurried early while in the four path through the turn, swung into mid-track for the drive then gained energy late and was closing in. BETTER WATCH OUT was in the three to the two path through the far turn, came into the lane from the three path and was surging at the end. RUN TROUBLE RUN was away alertly to set the pace at once, raced in the three path through the turn and into the lane, yielded to the winner with an eighth to go then was outfinished for positions late. TIGERBEACH chased the pace from the three path through the turn and into the lane, well placed with an eighth to go then lacked the needed kick. KATE'S GOLDEN DUDE was in the two path through the turn and into the lane then needed more inside the sixteenth.
