## **Footnotes**

SPEEDY NOW was away alertly to quickly gain the lead, cleared before entering the turn, continued on a clear advantage while near the inside and was never threatened while being ridden out. BREAK THE DEAL was in the two path through the turn when never far back, came into the lane from the two or three path and was under a drive to just get up for the place spot. IRON AGE chased the pace along the inside through the turn, continued near the inside through the lane and lost the place spot at the wire. SODA FOUNTAIN was steadied between rivals early while in the two path, shifted quickly into the five path and widest, remained in good position into the lane while in the six path and finished with good energy. HORACE CHARLES was in the four to the three path through the turn and was never a threat. EL CAPA ROJO raced in the two path through the turn and never factored. KAWA was in the three path through the turn when well back, swung into the lane widest and moved up while never a menace. LETITGO raced in the three to the two path through the turn, angled into the six path into the lane and never was a factor. PABLO'S DUKE was a step slow at the start to be well back, raced along the rail through the turn and was never in it. ACES AND EIGHTS hustled up from the four path into the turn to chase the winner through mid-turn then was done entering the lane. ADRI'S RANSOM trailed throughout while in the three to the two path.
