Footnotes

KENTUCKY ALLSTAR bobbled at the start, raced in the four path while stalking the leaders down the backstretch, bid three wide in mid-turn, dueled with another into the lane and edged up inside the eighth pole. MR ZYDECO was in the two path through the turns, bid into the lane from the four or five path and finished with good energy to be clear for the place spot. MOON LAUNCH stalked the pace from the three path into the far turn, bid in mid-turn with first jump on the winner, cleared into the lane, dueled with the winner inside the eighth pole then yielded and lost the place spot late. PROVERB vied for the early lead while between rivals, settled back off the pace, continued to lost ground through the turn and into the lane then found a belated effort. OFF SIXES vied for the lead from the two path into the turn then gave way in late turn. THE STORY BEGINS was steadied along behind rivals through the first turn, continued to track along the rail into the far turn then was done near the three-eighths pole. MY MAN ELVIS was in the three path through the turns and was finished in mid-turn. GO GERTIE GO was done after a half while in the two path through the turns. FINAL FLIGHT was in the four path through the first turn, continued well off the inside into the far turn, was asked for more entering the turn and was suddenly done.
