TACKETT was hustled to the lead, rounded the first turn in the two path, was well rated while setting the pace, came under a challenge in the two path on the far turn, accelerated clear when set down in upper stretch and drew off under steady urging. GROVE DADDY was off slow, spotted the front about three lengths, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and got up for the place. AFLEET MOMENT went around the first turn in the three path, tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the three path on the far turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch and weakened then was caught for the place while clear for the show. MOON LAUNCH was well placed just off the pace, drafted inside on the far turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, chased into the stretch and tired. BRING THE DOUGH broke out and bumped with a rival, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while moving from the rail to the two path on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. SARCILLO was bumped on both sides at the start, raced in the two path on the first turn, was reserved under a tight hold, came under urging while inside on the far turn and failed to threaten. PLUMB LINE bumped with a rival at the start, went around the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, was urged along in three path on the far turn and failed to respond. PAUL CANE went three wide on the first turn, was reserved near the back, rounded the far turn in the two path and was no factor.
