SHANGHAI TARIFF set the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn, faltered down the lane and lost place in the final stages. QUICK QUICK came out at the start and hit the gate, chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. GO LADY JAY tracked the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn and faded late in the stretch drive. FOXY MISCHIEF was never a threat. BIZZEE MISCHIEF was through after a half.
