

GUN IT saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, rallied to make a bid at the quarter-pole, kicked clear while still on his inside lead in upper stretch, switched to the proper lead at the furlong marker, was kept to the task into the final sixteenth then eased up late while much the best. BY MY STANDARDS bumped with a rival early on the first turn, went around that bend in the two path, settled off the pace, was urged along in the three path on the far turn and earned the place while no match for the winner. COURTYARD was reluctant to load, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced while urged along in the four then three path on the far turn, chased into upper stretch and proved no match for the winner then lost the place while clear for the show. TWELFTH LABOUR went four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, advanced while four then five wide on the far turn, held a good striking position into upper stretch but lacked the needed response. GROVE DADDY was last away, went three then four wide on the first turn, was reserved well back on the outside, rounded the turn in the three path, shifted five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. ROCKNROLL ROCKET rounded the first turn in the two path, was rated towards the front, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced in the two path on the far turn, bumped with a foe outside the quarter-pole, shifted three wide into the stretch and tired. BALLYHACK bumped with a foe early on the first turn, went three then four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch under the whip and failed to respond. CADE'S ON THE BUMP went three wide on the first turn, was reserved in the fort half of the field, chased three then two wide on the far turn and capitulated. MOON LAUNCH went three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside of the leader,

came up empty while dropping from the two path to the rail on the far turn, bumped with a rival while out of contention outside the quarter-pole and retreated. A MAN CALLED BOADY raced inside on the first turn, dropped well behind under vigorous urging on the backstretch, went two to three wide on the far turn and was outrun.
