COURTYARD broke a step slow, saved ground on the first turn, settled well back in the field, was urged along in the two path early on the far turn then angled four wide while advancing, moved out from behind horses in upper stretch, closed strongly to get the lead at the sixteenth-pole then drew clear under strong handling. YABBA DABBA DUDE went to the front, raced inside on the first turn, set the pace, extended the advantage late on the backstretch, drew off in the two path on the far turn, remained clear under a drive into the final furlong, was collared at the sixteenth-pole then drifted in while weakening late

but held the place. CASHANOVA was reluctant to load, bumped with a rival entering the first turn, saved ground on that bend, settled towards the front, came under urging late on the backstretch, went three then four wide on the far turn, chased the runner-up into the final furlong, moved in some while gaining into the final sixteenth, checked when the runner-up drifted in late and was clear for the show. MOON LAUNCH bumped with a rival into the first turn, went four wide on that bend, settled off the pace, moved in midway down the backstretch, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, dropped inward in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. DICTATOR went three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. CADE'S ON THE BUMP was hustled from the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the front, was urged along in the three path on the far turn and came up empty. DEFENDER broke a step slow, went four wide on the first turn, settled well back on the outside, advanced four then five wide on the far turn, shied out while failing to respond in upper stretch and had nothing left. JUST REVENGE was very unruly in the gate, raced in the three path on the first turn, settled near the back, went around the far turn from the inside to the two path, angled out in upper stretch and was no factor. THREE TWINS bumped with foes on both sides into the first turn, went two to three wide on that bend, dropped to the rail early on the backstretch, moved closer inside the five-eighths, came up empty along the rail on the far turn and retreated. EQUIVOCAL went around the first turn in the three path, tracked the pace on the outside, was urged along while three then two wide on the far turn and also retreated. HARDCORE FOLKLORE was very unruly in the gate, broke through the front of his stall door, was off a bit slow, quickly dropped well behind while racing well out in the track and was eased but walk
