Footnotes

DARLING VERA went around the first turn in the two path, was unhurried towards the rear, started the far turn in the three path then dropped to the rail, moved to the two path outside the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch, moved out near the furlong marker, shifted out more while gaining around the sixteenth-pole and closed fast to get up late. CLASSICAL MAGIC went to the front, set the pace near the inside, floated three wide into the stretch, responded well in the drive, led into the final sixteenth but was denied nearing the wire while just able to get the place. NOBLE FEVER went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced four wide on the far turn, came seven wide into the stretch and closed well to just miss while able to get show. TEMPLE CITY TERROR went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, gained in the two path into upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and finished with good energy to just miss the show. BEE BIT settled near the inside, was asked on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and also finished willingly. CLEAR AS DAY hit the outside of the gate at the start then bumped with a rival, lugged out into the first turn, dropped to the rail early on that bend, was well placed down the backstretch, chased in the two path on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and was out-kicked. ZAMZAM went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced five wide on the far turn, came eight wide into the stretch, was carried out some near the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed response. SOONER SCHOONER went five wide early on the first turn, dropped to the three path late on that bend, settled on the outside, was roused while three wide on the far turn, came seven wide into the stretch, was carried out some near the sixteenth-pole and also lacked the needed response. TRICK OF THE TAIL bumped with a rival at the start, saved ground on the first turn, drifted out

midway down the backstretch, moved in into the far turn, went two to three wide on that bend, drifted out late and was no threat. LORETTE went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, ranged up while three to four wide on the far turn, floated six wide into upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and weakened. FINEST JEWEL was last away, went around the first turn in the two path, settled towards the back, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch, drifted out late and was no factor. (Rail at 27 Feet)
