**Footnotes**

TIME IS MONEY had speed to set pace throughout, roused into the stretch and stayed clear under steady handling. TOMMY C ME was off slow, rushed inside to the turn, made a run at winner but did not have enough in the drive. ACES AND EIGHTS inside position to turn, angled out past the quarter pole but could not go on in the final furlong. TWO MILE CREEK chased winner to turn but weakened in the stretch run. ICE MUSIC broke slow and no speed to the turn and only improved position from mid track. PAY NO RENT no speed, split horses to the quarter pole but leveled off in the stretch run. MAJESTIC DESTINY inside run to turn but faded back thereafter. PEPPER'S CONCORD never a real menace. SILKY GOLD broke awkward and never played a role in the outcome. SAVEYOURMONYHONY was through early and dropped far back. REAL TALK TY broke sharp but was through after the half and dropped far back.
