ACES HIGH dueled from the outside early, battled up the backstretch, remained engaged through the second turn, shook loose at the eighth pole and steadily drew clear while kept to task. LUCKY PLAYER stalked the early pace from the inside, dropped back slightly up the backstretch, altered outside for the drive but was no match while clearly second best. FLY FRIENDLY SKY well placed from the inside, dropped back up the backstretch, dropped back, responded and rallied late for the show. YONADIXIE outrun early, advanced outside through the second turn, responded but was too late. CONDESTABLE pressed the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn but could not sustain the effort. IDOL CAT dueled from the inside and tired. CHARLIE'S AFFAIR was never a factor. TEE BROWN had a steady fade.
