MAL GUAPO set the pace form the outset, cleared on the lead into the backstretch, slowly widened through the turn then surged away when asked through the lane and was kept to the task while extending late. LADDIE BOY chased the pace along the inside through the turn, remained along the inside into the turn then dueled the last eighth for the place spot while not a threat to the top one. HOLIDAY MAN came out entering the first turn, raced in the two path while never far back, bid into the lane from the two or three path then lost the duel for place while never a serious threat. MISTER POLLARD tracked the winner along the inside through the turn, was asked for more outside of the quarter pole and was empty in the drive. BOURNE FREE stalked the pace while two wide and in the three path into the turn, floated into the five path into the lane and tired. ACES HIGH was in the three or four path through the turn and was done before reaching the quarter pole. THANK YOU KISSES was checked sharply entering the first turn when put in tight, re-gathered to trail the field while in the three or four path and was never in it. AFTER A STEWARD'S INQUIRY; #4 HOLIDAY MAN WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED 7TH (LAST) FOR INTERFERENCE ENTERING THE FIRST TURN.
