CLOSE THE GAP stalked the pace three wide, bid at the half-mile pole and drew off late under steady urging. HONOR THY MUNNINGS pressed the pace inside, bid at the three-eighths pole, then couldn't hold off the winner. FRISKY KITTEN stalked the pace between foes, then had no late bid. BLAME THE DREAM angled five wide at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. CLEVER RUN stalked the pace for a half mile before faltering. ENGLISH FLOWER improved position late inside. CASH TIZ WONDERFUL stalked the pace three wide, bid at the quarter pole but faltered. BE THE DAY raced evenly. TRADE SHOW made the pace for a half mile before giving way. KISSIN LUCKY LIPS was carried out at the quarter pole. CARMELA was not a factor. GIANT REVIEW faded.
