BLUEGRASS BEAT was hustled to the lead, raced in the two path on the first turn, set the pace, vied inside on the far turn, shook off a rival under one crack of a right-handed whip in upper stretch then switched to a left-handed whip and held under strong urging. DREAM IT AGAIN raced inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, was given one strike with a right-handed whip before the three-sixteenths then was switched to a left-handed whip, rallied while lugging in slightly and closed well but missed while clear for the place. CALMBEFORETHESTORM went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the two path on the far turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and weakened while able to get the show. MR. TICKLE was reserved in the two path on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SYLVIA'S WARRIOR went three wide on the first turn, settled well back in the field, dropped to the rail early on the far turn, saved ground from that point into the stretch, drifted out in the vicinity of the furlong marker and failed to threaten. WEALTH TO ME went five wide on the first turn, settled at the rear while on the outside, angled in midway down the backstretch, raced inside early on the far turn then came off the rail and failed to respond. NAKAMOTO went four wide on both turns and faltered.
