CHALK TALK led inside, was clear in the stretch and drifted out while kept to task. SUSAN'S REWARD rallied six wide at the quarter pole and closed late. DREAM IT AGAIN stalked the pace four wide, bid at the quarter pole, then lacked a late bid. AMERICAN ROAD stalked the pace inside, bid at the three-eighths pole, then faltered in the stretch. NAN'S PIERCE ARROW raced evenly. TIZ A DIXIE DANCER raced five wide around the first turn, pressed the pace outside of the winner, then gave way in the stretch. ESCALATE pressed the early pace four wide, then gave way. SABBATARIAN was not a factor. BIN DAAS was through early, then was eased and walked off.
