BLAZE'N PROSPECTOR contested the pace on the inside, responded well when asked after turning into the stretch then came under a right-handed whip, was challenged by the runner-up, switched to a left-handed whip at the eighth-pole, drifted out in the final sixteenth, made light contact with GREAT STUFF while carrying that rival out and narrowly prevailed. GREAT STUFF raced in the two path on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, drafted inside early on the far turn, angled three wide late on that bend, advanced to make an outside bid in upper stretch, dueled with the winner, was carried out by that rival in the final sixteenth and just missed. DREAM IT AGAIN settled on the inside, was asked at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. ALZANBAQ went two to three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced two to three wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and also lacked the needed response. POSTURE disputed the pace on the outside while racing in the two path, dropped back turning into the stretch and tired. PURGENALITY went three then two wide on the first turn, settled at the rear, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. ARCH RIVALRY went three wide on the first turn, raced just off the pace on the outside, chased three then four wide on the far turn, floated five wide into the stretch and faded. Following the race, the rider of GREAT STUFF claimed foul against the winner and the stewards' posted the inquiry sign. After the stewards' review, BLAZEN PROSPECTOR was disqualified from first and placed second for interference in the final
