U ROCK ROBIN prompted the pace two wide into the turn, made the lead, shook clear at the top of the stretch and lasted under strong handling. PEBBLES PICK close up in the three path, dropped inside on the turn, angled back out to the three path near the furlong marker, closed determinedly and just missed. IMPECCABLE prompted the pace three wide into the turn then finished evenly. CLONED TROUBLE raced outside while no factor. NANNY was hustled to the lead along the inside soon after the start, set a pressured pace into the turn, had speed into the stretch then weakened. DIG BLUE WATER had brief speed outside. WORDS HURT was outrun. RAINY DAY SONG was no factor. BARNSVLL E SHAMROCK had brief speed. QUEENS NOTICE was through early.
