Footnotes

J ZAR lagged far back for six furlongs, switched out to the far outside hitting his best stride at the top of the stretch, and rallied steadily to catch TOM'S LAST GENERAL in the final stride. TOM'S LAST GENERAL vied early inside STRIKE PLAY, moved clear getting a breather up the backstretch, shook off pursuers past the quarter-pole to go clear again, and was nailed at the wire. LUCK OF THE DRAW settled in midpack two wide for six furlongs, shifted out wider into the lane, and finished willingly between the top two. PLEASE SIT DOWN saved ground early, moved off the rail midway on the far turn, and finished evenly. HANDSOME HONEY was outrun early, advanced inside turning for home, and rallied mildly between rivals. SOULMATE raced three wide early in the second flight, and posed no threat. FIREWATER JAKE was four wide around the first turn, lodged a bid in the three-path approaching the lane, and faded in the final furlong. POPPY JOE ROCKS saved ground in easy striking range for six furlongs, and weakened in the stretch. STRIKE PLAY rushed up to the early lead after breaking a step slow, deferred to TOM'S LAST GENERAL on the first turn, bid between horses near the quarter-pole, then gave way. UNITY hopped slightly at the start, went five wide to the first turn, and never reached contention. LERO LERO raced four wide throughout and was outrun. MOON LAUNCH took the first turn three wide, and dropped back to trail inside before completing six furlongs.
