KING DEUCE dueled early, was challenged on the turn, responded to his cue and bounded clear in the stretch. LOVETHATCAUSE saved ground, was angled off the rail into the stretch and stayed on. DALE THE BUG MAN outrun early, was swung six wide into the stretch and managed a late rally. RUNAROUNDANCING outpaced early, advanced on the turn, lodged a five wide bid, was bumped at the sixteenth pole and kept on. IOWA NATIVE chased while four wide and lacked a rally. MOSTLY SUNNY raced forwardly while three wide and came up empty. HOT BLOODED SONG outrun early, lacked room in the stretch and was steadied at the sixteenth pole. VALLEY OF THE HIDE showed little. OSO READY forced the pace and weakened. FOLLOWING THE RACE, THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO POSSIBLE INTERFERENCE IN THE VICINITY OF THE SIXTEENTH POLE. AFTER REVIEWING VIDEOTAPED REPLAYS, THE Y MADE NO CHANGES TO THE ORDER OF FINISH
