Footnotes

DOWNSIDE SCENARIO settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch, rallied along the rail into the final furlong, moved out approaching the sixteenth-pole and closed fast to get up under strong handling. STORM TEMPLE PILOT quickly sped several lengths clear, saw that margin diminish before going a furlong, set the pace, was guided around the turn while lugging out in the two path, came under a drive in upper stretch, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was denied while clear for the place. SIEMPRE MIA was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, pursued the leader under a drive into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. LADY DIGGER veered out at the start and bumped with a rival, chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn and weakened. RIVER CITY LADY

broke in and a bit slow, was urged along off the pace, went three wide on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and improved position. COUNTON CLAIRE settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn, steadied when a rival came in at the furlong marker and failed to threaten. SHE'S A TEN broke a bit slow, raced well back in the field, went around the turn in the two path, swung seven wide into the stretch and never reached contention. LEMON LOVER broke a bit slow, moved in while settling under some urging, went two to three wide on the turn and also failed to threaten. ZIPPERINI was bumped on both sides at the start, moved up then was taken in hand late on the backstretch, raced in the two path on the turn and came up empty. ON THE HOOFFHA bumped with an opponent after the start, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased four wide on the turn and capitulated. SOPHIESHARDTOCATCH was urged along on the outside, went four to five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and had nothing left. GALILEA broke a bit slow, was ridden along while off the pace, went four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor. AMERICAN VALOR was urged along on the outside, went three to four wide on the turn and failed to respond. BRAN BRAN broke a bit slow, dropped well behind, saved ground on the turn and was outrun.
