**Footnotes**

STORM TEMPLE PILOT set the pace from the onset, angled off the rail in the turn, remained clear in the stretch and held sway in the final stages. CAT TEN tracked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. COVEY TRACE chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch drive. JOKASA stalked the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn and weakened down the lane. MARY MAHONEYS GIRL angled off the rail in the turn with a belated gain in the stretch. EXXIMIA (ARG) fanned into the five path in the turn with some gain in the stretch. MY CELESTE was well placed early, shifted into the three path in the turn and leveled out down the lane. STORIED TALE fanned into the seven path in the turn and raced widest down the lane. HEARTBREAK HILL was never a threat. MERCER MILL MAE was through after a half.
