HONOR DEPUTY, in touch with the pacesetter prompting that foe racing to the turn, lost some ground to that foe nearing upper stretch but continued with a steady bid to wrest the advantage in late stages under firm encouragement. RUNAWAY WIND broke readily to gain the advantage in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing a bit off the rail into the turn, dueled for command past midstretch but came up second best. FLORIDA TWO STEP tracked off the first flight in early stages, shifted out four wide nearing the bend advancing on those rivals, continued in that path to upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. COMMAND CODE settled between foes in early stages, angled out three deep racing into the lane and gained some position while no real threat. PROPER CROSS was settled last, angled to the inside, saved ground throughout but had no closing bid. FACTORY MADE, forwardly placed along the rail in the opening stages attending the pace, gave way into the lane. SMOKE BREAK tracked outside foes off the second flight early but offered no rally.
