THE MOMENT IS NOW cleared into the first turn without much resistance, shifted off the rail down the backstretch, kicked further away in hand around the far turn without receiving a challenge, and widened under mild urging through the lane. HIGH POWERED tracked the loose leader, was driven into the far turn as the leader got away, but failed to make a bid and got outpaced around that bend, then held place in the lane. DRAGUNOV settled far off the pace and stayed in that position around the far turn, then made a three to four wide rally into the lane, but missed place. EYES ON raced midpack multiple legnths off the loose leader, regressed and lost ground down the backstretch, but made a gain in the three path around the far turn to be in range of place into the lane, but hung, and got outfinished between rivals. FRIEND ZONE trailed by a distance to the quarter pole and was never involved. ROAD TO CAIRO raced in midpack along the inside, but was driven to keep pace into the far turn and made no rally, then weakened.
