TROCKETTE stalked along the inside, advanced in hand to the pocket into the far turn, was put to a drive at the five-sixteenths pole, looked outpaced into the lane, then shifted three wide passing the furlong marker, showed late interest, rallied between horses and caught the tiring leader at the wire. HIGH POWERED prompted the pace two wide, made a bid between horses into the far turn, dueled for the lead around the second bend, inched an advantage into the lane, but tired in the late stages and drifted in inside the final furlong, and got caught at the wire. PURR CAT stalked four to five wide through the first turn, advanced on the leader into the backstretch, stayed in range until the far turn, where he got outpaced by the leaders without being persevered with, stayed on while hanging on her left lead in the four path into the lane, then made a late rerally inside the final furlong, but got outkicked. OBTAINED set a pressured pace along the inside, was challenged by HIGH POWER and dueled with that rival around the far turn, dug in gamely in upper stretch and as the aforementioned foe tired at the furlong pole, but got outfinished for minor rewards. AULD CUP was bumped hard between horses at the start, settled far off the pace along the inside, saved ground through the turns and produced an inside rally through the lane, then met traffic at the wire, causing the rider to stop driving, but was not cost a placing. TOMAHAWK KITTEN raced far back and two wide between fores, then along the inside through the far turn, and made no rally. JUST ANOTHER JOHN broke far back, but pulled his way between horses through the first turn to be midpack into the backstretch, settled approaching the five-furlong marker, stayed far back down the backstretch, then went seven wide into the lane, and made no bid. MY KINDA KID stalked

three wide early on, but regressed into the backstretch and faded passing the quarter pole. SPATETACULAR JOE trailed in the three path through the first turn, made a four wide blitz starting at the half mile pole, was in range of the leaders at the quarter pole, but weakened when drifted to the six path into the lane, and subsequently faded. ALBIREO was driven along early while far back and three wide, then shifted to the eight path into the lane, and was never involved.
