TWO EAGLES circled trouble around the first turn, roused in a three wide rush turned for home in front and stayed clear with left hand urging to the wire. OAKS HONEY close up three wide up the backstretch, with winner to the far turn and stayed on for second best while no match for the winner. TWILIGHT KING inside speed to the half, collard and hung around the third spot while no match for the top two. INSPIRED TO ROCK no speed to far turn inside, swung out past the quarter pole and moved up in the stretch. EL CHEAPO never a threat and only improved position in the stretch. THE BIG GAMBLER tried hard to the half but was used up and dropped far back. CIGAR BOAT was through after half with a steady fade from that point. CONNORRSKIE dueled early on, swallowed up at the half and dropped far back to gallop past the wire.
