TEMPLE CITY TERROR raced back early on, was in the four path into the lane, altered out down the lane, rallied late in the stretch and coasted past the leaders five wide in the final stages. SISTER HANAN chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn, made a bid down the lane, was under a long drive while three wide late and prevailed for place in the final stages. PIECE BY PEACE set the pace early, was on the inside into the lane, under a long drive down the lane, was between horses late, yielded and did not have enough for place in the final stages. LADY ROSALIE (IRE) was bumped early on, chased the pace along the inside, angled off the rail into the lane, was blocked down the lane, altered to the inside near the eighth pole, made a bid but hung in the late stages. RODHWAAN was back early on, fanned into the five path entering the lane, rallied down the lane, made a bid four wide late but was

in tight and steadied in the final stages. ALLONGE stalked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch run. SUGAR LOVE tracked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. KEEPTHE MAIN THING shifted into the three path in the far turn and ran on late in the stretch drive. WHOS TO BLAME was slow at the start, steadied early on and near the five sixteenths pole. TWELVE MONARCHS was never a threat. CHIKARA bobbed at the start and never rallied down the lane. SEA SERENADE (GB) was off slowly and trailed the field throughout.
