GRAND MEISTER set the pace early, was off the rail into the lane, drew clear down the lane under a steady drive. ECRU chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn, made a bid down the lane but had no late gain in the winner in the final stages but was second best. MOON LAUNCH was back early on, fanned into the five path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. AGAINST THE LINE chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn and leveled off late in the stretch drive. HEZA HANDFUL was bumped at the start, chased the pace early, was on the inside into the lane and improved position late. LEA RIDGE came in, bumped foe and bobbed at the start. FLUELLEN tracked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn and was tired down the lane. LUCKY BODE was through after a half. JOHNNY STRONG was never involved. ENGLISH HUMOR was done early.
