TEMPLE CITY TERROR was unhurried early on, raced in the five path into the lane, rallied down the lane, drove past the leader late and cleared while going away in the final stages. FIERCE SCARLETT was bumped hard at the start and raced back early on, was in the five path into the lane, made a bid late in the stretch but was no match for the winner in the final stages. EDGEE ANGEL raced back early on, was in the three path into the lane and moved up in the stretch run. DEVIOUS CHARM raced back early on, was off the rail into the lane and improved position late in the stretch drive. LOST TICKET stalked

the pace early, was on the inside into the lane, shied from the hedge along the rail in the upper stretch and weakened late in the drive. QUIET DIGNITY came in at the start and raced back early on, was off the rail into the lane and improved position. WELL SPENT pressed the pace early, was in the three path into the lane, took over and inched ahead in the stretch but faltered late in the drive. MISSION FROM ELLE chased the pace early, was in the four path into the lane, made a bid down the stretch but hung in the late stages. LAS RAMBLAS was never a threat. DUCHESS OF SUSSEX was empty after a half. GLAMOUR GAL was steadied along early on. CLAUDIA JEAN (IRE) was bumped and bothered at the start, set the pace for three quarters then gave way readily.
