MOON LAUNCH pressed the leader through the first turn to the far turn, passed that one while in tandem with another foe, briefly dueled and drew off at the top of the stretch to win clear. RIONERO was unhurried inside, angled out to pass a fading foe heading into the far turn, stayed on the rail in the stretch and closed well. FALLS ROAD raced three wide on the first turn, dueled the winner on the far turn and lost position in the stretch to settle for third. KALYDAR was bothered at the start, raced well gapped off the field, and passed a galloping foe in the strewtch. MUSICAL INTEREST raced in front while nside to the turn, dropped back and galloped past the wire.
