**Footnotes**

FORBETTERORWORSE sharp speed to the lead, confidently handled from the quarter pole and held on to the wire in a good effort. UNCLE EARL chased winner to deep stretch with a late surge at the wire. ROYAL LEIGE had a rough start, lagged far back to turn angled out coming on. GET SOME MO good position from inside stayed on rail with a good finish. BEST YOU EVER SEEN bobbled at the start, rushed inside to turn, flattened out late. MY MAE DAY outrun to the turn, moved up in the stretch run from inside. COMMAND CODE never a menace. BOURBON MOMENT wide run throughout and faded quickly. ABSOLUTE CONTROL stumbled at the start, rushed to turn, used up, gave way and was vanned off after the finish. TRAMORE BAY never a threat from the start.
