HONOR THE D raced in the second flight off the leaders, rallied four wide on the turn, caught the leaders in upper stretch and widened under urging for the win. NUTTIN' FASTER bore out at the start, raced wide in the second flight, came very wide into the stretch and steadily gained for the place. CONJURING challenged the leader in the three path on the turn, lost the place spot late while best of the rest. SIR LEONIDAS was unhurried off the rail. bore out and bumped a foe entering the turn, and improved position down the stretch while running even. MY PARDNER CAL chased in the four path, contended to mid stretch and faltered. THIS MAN CAN contended off the rail, but gave way at the eighth pole. HENNY HEFNER bounced between horses at the start, moved up the rail to the second flight, but faded on the turn.
