G'S SHIP LOAD broke awkward, raced well off the front, closed the gap while six wide on the turn and closed steadily for the win. CONJURING led a pressured pace off the rail, drew ahead at the half mile pole, was headed on the turn and fought down the stretch to get clear for second late. EDGE OF PLEASURE pressured the leader to the half, backed off a bit, headed the leader outside on the turn and dueled down the stretch, getting beat for place late. DOLLY DEAR was off slow, chased the leaders from well back at the rail, dropped back a bit on the turn, then re-rallied inside to catch the leading group down the stretch before flattening out. ROCKY PARADE was under a ride on the turn and lacked a needed rally. HEAVENLY MINE was wide into the stretch and lacked a rally.
