

HEADFIRST vied outside a foe early, led clear on the turn and stayed safe to the finish. APPEALING JULIA chased from inside, went out to the five path on the turn and steadily gained down the lane to get the place spot. MAUK'S TUFF was last early, took the rail in the lane and closed well late. LA COYOTA vied inside, then reverted to chasing the leader down the lane and leveled out late. KANTASTIC was pinched off at the start, stayed back to the stretch, and gained position late. DRAMA RUN was miid pack, came widest into the stretch and had some late gain. STORM TEMPLE PILOT chased up close from outisde to mid stretch and tired.
