**Footnotes**

FREEDOM FACTOR well placed from the outside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, responded entering the drive, dueled through the drive and inched clear late. CHICAGO BLUES unhurried early from the inside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded entering the drive and was just up for the place. MANGELSEN broke sharp from the outside, gained the early margin, dueled up the backstretch, remained engaged through the second turn, battled through the drive but could not match strides. HALF OURS TO KEEP outrun early, advanced outside through the second turn, responded entering the drive and had a late rally. BIG BOBBY BROWN pressed the early pace outside but came up empty in the drive. MEGANS LAD forced the early pace from the outside, dueled up the backstretch, battled through the second turn, remained engaged entering the drive but faded late. OVER FUNDED was no factor. PLEASANT D'ORO chased the early pace and tired. COWBOY BLING was never close.
