CHESS CHIEF saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, rallied to make a bid in upper stretch then took the lead, battled outside of the runner-up in the final furlong, drifted out near the sixteenth-pole and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. COWBOY DIPLOMACY was hustled to the lead, went around the first turn in the two path, set the clear pace through moderate fractions, vied inside on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, drifted out under heavy pressure near the furlong marker then again around the sixteenth-pole and was denied. ENFORCEABLE rounded the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, was urged along while moving from three to five wide on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a strong drive and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. SPA CITY broke out at the start, went three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid at the seven-sixteenths, vied in the two to three path on the far turn and tired. PLUS QUE PARFAIT bumped lightly with a rival at the start, went four wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and weakened. BIG BEAUTIFUL WALL was carried out at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled near the back, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. HARVEY WALLBANGER brushed the inside of the gate at the start then bumped lightly with a foe and was last away, angled in at the rear, saved ground on the turns and failed to respond.
