CLEAR FOR ACTION vied throughout, inside, dug in gamely in the final eighth to prevail on the wire. OLD TIMER'S DAY sharp break outside, vied with winner throughout but outfinished and stayed game. KATE'S GOLDEN DUDE raced four wide to quarter pole while well placed and stayed tenacious to wire. CAN'T SAY NO raced between horses to the turn and just weakened in the stretch. COROT dueled early on from inside to turn but gave way from quarter pole. QUICKSILVER never threatened. ZOMBIE was through early and faded back. SAVE THE DRAMA had a steady fade with an inside trip. TORAZO never menaced. JUNIOR GILLIAM backed off from the start, raced widest into the stretch while no threat.
