TURN TO ME SUCREE was well placed early, rallied in the stretch on the rail, finished full of run and widened late under mild urging to win as much the best. FACEYS FIRST vied for the lead three wide until mid stretch, was no match for the winner late but held place. LUMINAIRE was never far back early, had a mild bid while no threat. HOPES AND PRAYERS was well placed early and went evenly late. THE NEW MIAMI raced mid pack, saved ground and was no menace. EOWYN'S PARADISE raced mid pack and was no threat. NATALIA'S TEMPLE was no factor. BETTER THAN PEARLS allowed to settle, failed to menace. SUMMER HOURS had good early speed, then faded quickly in the stretch. YACHT broke in the air and was outrun.
