FRONT CIRCLE was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead two wide into the stretch and shook clear under strong handling. TIVIS vied for the lead along the inside into the turn, shifted out to the four path, had a mild late rally and finished clear for second. SPEAK LIGHTLY dueled with the winner along the inside into the stretch and faded late. WINDY LU WHO passed tiring rivals in the five path. INSPIRING LILY with the second flight four wide, failed to respond. HIGHLY EXPLOSIVE stalked the pace three wide into the stretch then gave way. NORTHERN JOURNEY was bumped at the start and outrun. BOOGIE BOOGIE bore out at the start bumping rivals and was through early.
