RHYTHM SECTION bumped with MIGHTY TOUGH at the start, lagged far back early, began picking off rivals four wide around the far turn, came out a bit further rallying into the stretch, caught the leaders from outside a furlong out, lugged in sharply to the rail after drawing clear and was saved by the wire. ALONZO MOSELY steadied keyed up along the inside into the first turn, remained well back after six furlongs near the two-path, angled to the far outside finding stride in upper stretch, closed steadily and came up just short outside the winner. MALIBU EDGE was outrun to the stretch, and finished with good energy while no threat to the top two. TURN OF EVENTS raced four wide much of the way, and flattened out late. GIMME SOME MO advanced with a bid three wide on the far turn, fought on to the furlong grounds and weakened. GHOSTLORE moved up outside rivals approaching the far turn, cut the corner getting in range at the top of the stretch, but could not sustain the rally. LIGHT CRUISER was no factor three wide on the turns. COUNTERSTRIKE set a pressured pace inside for six furlongs, and gave way in the stretch. MIGHTY TOUGH was bumped between horses at the start, and never reached contention. ABSAM bumped with MIGHTY TOUGH at the start, pressed the pace outside, and had nothing left in the stretch. WALK UP MUSIC was forwardly placed inside to the far turn, and tired. SEVEN AND SEVEN stayed in range two wide early, and tired.
