Footnotes

SCALDING hopped at the start, raced in the three path along the first turn while well placed, was in the three path through the far turn, took over command in the stretch, opened up down the lane and held safely in the final stages. DYNAMIC ONE was a bit slow at the start and raced back early on, was in the three path into the lane, rallied down the lane and was gaining in the final stages. PROXY came out at the start, chased the pace early on, raced in the two path along the far turn, was in the five path into the lane, made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. WARRANT raced in the three path along the first turn, stalked the early pace, was on the inside into the lane and weakened late in the stretch run. TARTUFO trailed the field early on, raced in the three path along the far turn, was in the six path into the lane and moved up in the stretch drive. MIGHTY HEART set the pace along the first turn, dueled down the backstretch and the far turn, was in the two path into the lane and empty down the lane. COWBOY DIPLOMACY was on the inside along the first turn, dueled from the rail down the backstretch, was in the two path into the lane and tired in the stretch run.
