

Footnotes

SIR OLLIE went up to take over outside REBELDE approaching the half-mile pole, edged away after six furlongs shifting inward, responded when hooked from outside by DISC JOCKEY into the lane and withstood a long drive to get the decision. DISC JOCKEY loomed three wide coming to the quarter-pole, battled outside SIR OLLIE through the stretch and came up second best. REBELDE led early inside, could not hold off challengers leaving the backstretch, dropped back through the turn, then ran on well enough to snag the show. CAXAMBAS CANDY moved off the inside to the three-path on the turn, and failed to menace. ASSERTIKO pressed the early pace, lodged a mild bid into the turn three then two wide, then weakened approaching the top of the stretch. CRITICAL THREAT showed early speed between horses, but was through before reaching the turn. PERFECT SILENT CAT showed little trailing throughout.
